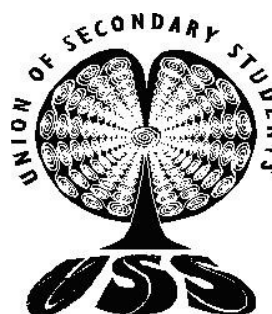

The Union of Secondary Students is the national representative organisation for second level student nationwide. Established in 2001, we are now active partners in the Irish educational system. The Union is entirely apolitical, and is a natural extension of the Student Council infrastructure currently in place in many schools in Ireland, with the Union providing a voice for students on a national level. Our areas of concern are diverse, with topics such as the state examinations system and student welfare topping the agenda. We work with numerous bodies, such as the National Parents' Council, the teachers' unions, and indeed the Department of Education and Science in order to further advance our education system and improve many aspects of student life.

During the course of this event, delegates will participate in discussion and debate around a number of topics, and they will elect the leadership of the USS for the year ahead. We will provide accommodation in a Dublin hostel for anyone who needs it – this is covered by the conference fee. Delegates need only pay for their own transport and meals.

There will be constant supervision by our third level counterpart, the Union of Students in Ireland, both at the venue and in the hostel, and the event will be held on the grounds of the Department of Education and Science, close to all amenities and travel termini.
